


Fig. 1 Decorated sheet gold fragment number 14. Positive relief on the left. The composite photographic illustrations accompanying this report were made by the author using digital micro-photographs taken by David Brown, of the School of Geography, Archaeology and Palaeoecology, Queen's University, Belfast.




Fig. 2 Foil sheet number 1.




Fig. 4 Other probable (9, 15a, 15b) and possible (3, 4)'stud' covers.




Fig. 5 Strips 6a and 6b.




Fig. 6 Pellets (7, Xa and Xb) and runs (13 and 16).
