SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES

Articles should be submitted to the Editor:

Contributors should indicate both their e-mail and postal address.

SUBMITTED FORMAT:

All articles should be submitted electronically as both a pdf and in a standard word processing format (the preferred format is Microsoft Word for Mac or PC [XP/97/2000/2003 *.doc]); if any other format is submitted, a copy of the text should also be saved in RTF to facilitate file conversion). Figure captions are treated as text and should be appended to the text of the article. Phonetic marks should be clear and distinct.

All tables and figures should be submitted separately. Figures may be submitted on disc or electronically in any format supported by Adobe Photoshop or Illustrator.

All submitted articles should include an abstract and follow the style sheet indicated below.

FOOTNOTES:

Footnotes should not be used for referencing but only for additional comment.

TEXT REFERENCES:

Text references should follow the following format:

(Zimmer 1990, 145-150)

Please note:

- a) position of comma,
- b) full page numbers (not 145-50),
- c) avoid the use of 'ibid', 'op cit', 'loc cit'.

TABLES AND FIGURES:

All tables and figures should be submitted separately. Do not embed them in your text file.

Figures may be submitted on disc or electronically in any format supported by Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator or Inkscape.

Line drawings, plans or calibration charts (Calib, OxCal etc.) preferably as SVG vector-graphics (most calibration programmes provide the option to save charts as SVG), however, if vector-graphics are not possible as JPGs/PNGs with 1200 DPI.

Photographs and charts/maps such as e.g. magnetic susceptibility maps etc. as grayscale images with values from "white" to "dark gray", NOT as RGB colours. The resolution should be at least 600 DPI.

Please size tables and figures/plates according to the format of the layout, i.e.

- (a) width of full type area is 180 mm, width of single columns is 87.5 mm
- (b) height (including captions) max. = 250.5 mm (1/2 = 122.5 mm 1/3 = 80 mm 1/4 = <math>58.5 mm)

N.B. Please leave enough room for the caption at the bottom!
